

Annual Primary RE Conference 2018

Presented by the HIAS RE team, this is a popular annual event that RE leaders always find worthwhile and enjoyable. It offers an ideal opportunity to refresh your RE practice, as well as network with RE lead colleagues and the RE team.

This year's keynote speaker is Denise Cush (BA Oxford, MA Lancaster, PhD Warwick) who held the post of Professor of Religion and Education at Bath Spa University until she retired in 2015. She has taught Religious Studies in a sixth form college, trained both primary and secondary teachers in RE, and taught Study of Religions at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. She is deputy editor of the *British Journal of Religious Education*. In addition to RE, her teaching and research interests include Buddhism, Hinduism, Christianity and alternative spiritualities such as Paganism.

The day will also include a choice of workshops including:

- *Creative ideas for teaching excellent RE*: helping teachers use cross curricular themes for their RE, using art, craft, drama, English, Philosophy for children and DT to bring out creative, enquiry based learning (led by the primary RE Steering Group)
- *Christian concepts*: focusing on the practical ideas teachers can use for teaching a variety of Christian concepts (led by the RE Adviser for the C of E Diocese of Portsmouth)
- *Effective use of persona dolls* (led by Minnie Moore, HIAS Rights and Diversity Centre)
- subject booster workshops on different faiths that will develop your skills and expertise.

Delegates will gain knowledge and understanding of:

- new developments in RE, locally and nationally, including SMSC
- the impact of these developments on RE teaching
- ideas to support colleagues and improve teaching and learning in RE.

Participants will learn how to:

- identify and develop priorities for RE development
- provide effective subject leadership.
