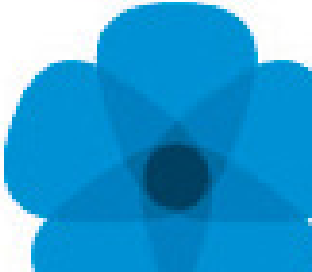

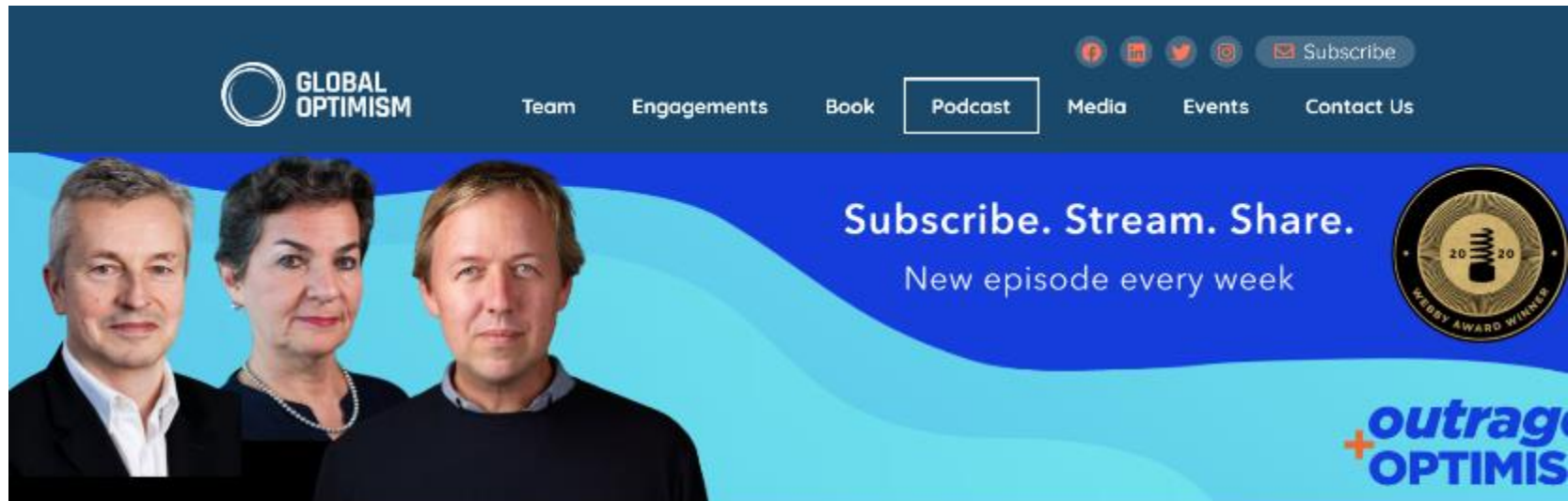

If the Earth were only a few feet in diameter.”

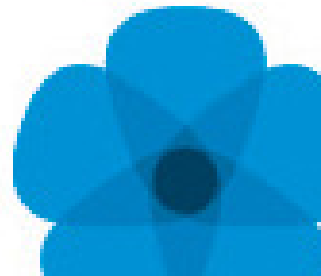
