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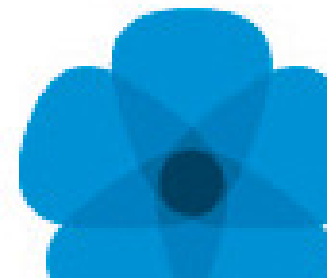
# Overview

## **This document contains...**

Information on how to create a QR code and add it to your contribution to the Climate Crisis Installation artwork (abstract tree and bunting).

## **Points to consider when using this resource**

The QR codes will go on the abstract tree and bunting, they will need to be laminated (weatherproofed).



## QR code

- Go to an App store and load a QR code creator/scanner.
- Go to QR code creator
- Input text to create QR code, press generate.
- Print and test scanning.
- Laminate and trim and add to Totem and add to bunting.

Sloths are the slowest mammals on the planet they do everything at the same, measured pace. This is their strategy for survival! The sloths main predators (Jaguars, Ocelots and Harpy Eagles) all primarily detect their prey visually, and sloths move at a pace that simply goes unnoticed!

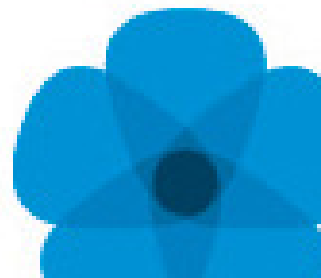
