

Hampshire and Wessex annual religious education conference 2023

Thursday 19 October 2023

This cross-phase conference is for primary, secondary and SEND RE teachers and leaders of RE.

The conference is to support teachers to teach RE well with *Living Difference IV*, the locally agreed syllabus for RE in Hampshire, Isle of Wight, Portsmouth and Southampton schools. Delegates will gain confidence in representing what it means to live with a religious orientation on life, in the classroom.

The day will include keynote plenary sessions, invaluable for all teachers in every phase of education, as well as phase-specific workshops and discussion opportunities, including exam board-specific GCSE workshops.

Workshops will include a choice from the following: Christianity, Buddhism, transition, golden threads, SEND, and creative and engaging strategies for RE.

Teachers attending the conference will:

- gain confidence to teach RE well in their school
- gain confidence in the subject knowledge required to teach RE well
- gain confidence in making curriculum with *Living Difference IV* to ensure all children and young people make progress
- ensure RE taught in school supports whole school values.
