

The Jewish Living Experience Exhibition is coming to Bournemouth from **2-12 November 2026**.

The Jewish Living Experience Exhibition has been held all over the UK. The Exhibition offers students hands-on insight into Jewish culture and lifecycle events. Specifically:

1. There are 15 banners and interactive displays covering festivals, Shabbat, food, levels of observance from different communities, and many other aspects of Jewish life.
2. Artefacts are available that can be handled by students, and these include the shofar and Jewish games such as a dreidl.
3. There will be educational support aligned with UK RE curricula and this will be accompanied by teachers' packs and guided sessions. *
4. Each visit will take approximately 1 1/2 hours and will include an explanation of all the different aspects as well as about the Synagogue.

*To support schools attending the exhibition there will be:

Teachers' Packs: Schools receive comprehensive packs outlining how each exhibition panel aligns with national Religious Education (RE) and Citizenship frameworks.

Student Activity Worksheets: Ready-to-print student worksheets are provided to guide children through the displays independently.

Bespoke Digital Lesson Support: For schools utilising the [Jewish Living Online platform](#), modules require minimal planning or prior subject knowledge, featuring pre-built critical thinking questions and assessment tools.
